# The Performing Arts Centre

and Conference Meeting Space



The Performing Arts Centre is a versatile and vibrant hub for creativity, offering a range of purpose-built facilities designed to accommodate a wide variety of performances and events. It features two fully equipped indoor theatres, an open-air theatre perfect for summer productions, a bright and airy dance studio, and a music department comprising several individual practice rooms.

At the heart of the building is a spacious central foyer, complete with a licensed bar located on the first floor, where guests can enjoy refreshments during breaks or intervals.

Exclusive hire of the venue ensures a unique and adaptable environment, perfect for hosting performances, corporate conferences, and private functions.

## **Humphreys Hall**

The Humphreys Hall is a purpose built theatre situated in the new Performing Arts Centre on the first and second floor. It has tiered theatre seating with a maximum capacity of 338 seats, which can retract, transforming it into a large hall on one level. It has a generous stage area for performances with theatre curtains and has a backstage area too making it perfect for a concert or live event. It has a theatre sound desk, lighting rigs, a lectern with microphone and a built in PA system. For presentations or conferences, there is a motorised large screen, which can be suspended in front of the curtains, which act as a backdrop.

Refreshments can be served in the central foyer during breaks or intervals, timed with other rooms requiring the use of this space should they be occupied. If you prefer to have exclusive use of the Performing Arts Centre for your event then the whole venue can be hired.

## **Deayton Theatre**

The Deayton is a spacious, modern theatre and drama space located on the first floor of the Performing Arts Centre. Its design features floor-to-ceiling panoramic windows that flood the room with natural light, while fitted blackout blinds provide flexibility for performances, presentations, or events requiring complete darkness. The theatre is equipped with retractable tiered seating for 67. For larger events, additional free-standing seating can be arranged at the front of the hall, expanding the capacity to accommodate up to 107 attendees.

The stage area can accommodate a panel, a lectern and it also has a suspended screen with front projection making it suitable for conferences and presentations as well as music or drama performances.


A dividing screen can be lowered from the ceiling, transforming the space into two separate rooms, each with its own entrance and exit, if required.

Refreshments can be served in the central foyer for breaks or intervals.

## **Dance Studio**

The Dance Studio is a modern, bright, and airy space specifically designed for drama and dance activities, located on the ground floor of the Performing Arts Centre. Its contemporary design makes it a versatile environment for rehearsals, classes, and performances. The studio features floor-to-ceiling panoramic windows, equipped with adjustable privacy blinds, allowing plenty of natural light to flood the room.

One of the studio's standout features is a full wall of mirrors, ideal for students and performers to observe their movements and perfect their routines. The built-in Bluetooth sound system allows for easy, high-quality audio playback. Additionally, the studio is equipped with air conditioning, ensuring a comfortable temperature is maintained year-round, even during high-energy sessions.

Dimensions: 10.83m x 8.22m




## **Orchard Theatre**

The Orchard Theatre is a charming outdoor performance space, offering a unique and serene setting for your performance or gathering. It features a wooden decked performing area, complemented by a gently sloping grass bank fitted with benches, which create naturally tiered seating for up to 72 people. Surrounded by beautiful apple trees, the theatre boasts a picturesque and tranquil feel.

The Orchard Theatre is conveniently accessed from the central foyer on the first floor of the Performing Arts Centre, making it an ideal ancillary space for events that would benefit from an outside area.










## The Foyer




# Floorplan

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Is parking available?

Yes, we offer ample on-site parking for your guests. If required, signage will be provided to guide them to the designated parking areas on the day of your event.

#### Do we need to provide car park attendants?

Yes, you will need to arrange your own car park attendants to manage parking for your guests. With enough notice we can provide them if needed, at a cost.

#### Is the venue accessible for people with disabilities?

The Performing Arts Centre is located at the top of a hill and there are a number of stairs to climb to reach it from the main car park. It is possible to drive up to the back of the Centre and drop off guests with mobility issues so they can avoid the stairs however the driver must then park in the main car park. Once inside the venue there is an accessible lift to take guests with mobility issues to the first floor of the Humphreys and the ground floor of the building. Due to the theatre seating being fixed, any wheelchair users must be positioned in front of the first row of theatre seats. There is an accessible toilet in the Humphreys next to this area. This is clearly marked on our seating plans.

#### Can you sell tickets for our show or help market our event?

Unfortunately, we do not handle ticket sales. We recommend using platforms such as Eventbrite to manage ticketing for your show. We can help with marketing and promoting your event on our social platforms if deemed appropriate.

Please speak to your venue contact.

#### Can we provide our own technicians?

The short answer is yes, however you would most likely need to have one of our technical team there to oversee the use of our equipment unless otherwise agreed with the venue.

#### Do we need to provide ushers?

Yes, you are responsible for providing ushers to assist with your event if needed. There are four entry points to the theatre, two on the first floor and two on the second floor.



## Frequently Asked Questions Continued...

#### How do you decide whether our event requires additional costs for security?

This is decided through a risk assessment of your event which takes into consideration factors such as the nature of your event, number of attendees and whether alcohol is being served.

#### Can we provide our own bar?

If you are providing any form of alcohol sales then unfortunately we do not allow anyone else to provide the bar. If your bar is soft drinks only and snacks that do not require any cooking then yes you can. Please note that if you are taking card transactions you are not permitted to use our Wi-Fi for this. You must provide your own Wi-Fi dongle suitable for this purpose.

#### Are drinks allowed in the Humphreys?

No, as a general rule of thumb, we do not allow food or drinks in the Humphreys hall.

#### What is the Wi-Fi like in the venue?

We have a stand alone Wi-Fi for external lettings in the school which is separate to the Schools secure one. We can provide this to the event organisers in advance of the event. This network is filtered and you should advise in advance of what you need to access online so we an ensure it is unblocked.

#### What is the mobile signal like at the venue?

The most reliable mobile network providers in the venue is EE or Three. Any other providers have very limited signal, if any.

#### Is there a stage?

There is a fixed, raised stage in the Humphreys Hall. The standard dimensions are 14.64 m (W) x 4.88 m (D) x 0.23 m (H). The stage can be reconfigured to make it deeper by taking the side blocks off the wings and repositioning them at the front to form stage dimensions of 12.2 m (W) x 6.1 m (D) x 0.23 m (H).

There is no stage in the Deayton however staging blocks can be provided to create a temporary one for your event.

#### Is the stage suitable for dancing?

Due to the stage being made up of individual wooden staging blocks it is unsuitable for bare feet however we can install Harlequin dance flooring on top. This needs to be installed the day before to allow it to rest, so there does need to be availability to do this in advance. Please check with your venue contact who can advise.
